Congregational Meeting: We will have a congregational meeting following worship today to vote on two recommendations from our Officers. The first is a proposal to meet Bonclarken’s *Today and Tomorrow* campaign challenge with a gift of \$25,000, with funding as follows: \$10,000 from the Mary Beth Craven Kennedy estate gift, \$10,000 from 2017 BBQ proceeds, \$5,000 from General Fund. The second recommendation is to accept a bid from Parker Productions to install a new comprehensive sound system in the sanctuary, fellowship hall, and education building for \$42,769 to be paid out of the Johnston fund.
