

We are excited to be starting a new year of Covenant Kids with your wonderful children. This year we will continue the process of learning the Children's Catechism. Last year, we focused on questions 58-108. This year we will be focusing on questions 109-150. It is our hope that in learning the Catechism, the children will become familiar with theological vocabulary and will gain a deeper understanding for who God is and what we as Christians believe. We would like to encourage you to work with your children at home in memorizing the questions, with the end goal of reciting these answers before an Elder or Pastor Andrew at the end of the year of Covenant Kids. Those who have memorized and recited the questions will be acknowledged on a Sunday morning and will be presented with a book of their choosing from Pastor Andrew's shelves. It is our prayer that as our children hide these truths about God in their hearts, they will begin to build a solid foundation upon which they can later stand firm.
